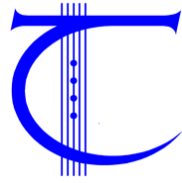


Tyndale Choral Society

Tyndale Choral Society is delighted to offer another Improvers' Class in 2012. Led by John Hicks, the class will offer further tuition in sight-reading, choral technique and relevant theory. Each week we will work on a piece chosen to illustrate one particular aspect of choral singing including: intervals, phrasing, rhythms and following a conductor. The emphasis will be practical; this isn't a *sit and listen* course, it's a *learn, understand and try it out experience* - be prepared to sing!

A warm welcome will be extended to anybody who feels that he or she could benefit from extra coaching; the course is *not* restricted to members of the society.

The class will run on Monday evenings from 6th February to 12th March, 19:30 to 21:30, in the Methodist Church, Dursley. The course fee is £15.

John Hicks, a current member of the society, was first engaged as a tutor (choral music and opera) by the Inner London Education Authority in 1971 and for many years conducted both the Southwark Madrigal Group and the Streatham Hill Operatic Society. From 1977, working as a tutor for Goldsmiths College he conducted the Goldsmiths Singers (leading them to win their class in the Lewisham Festival of Music, Drama and Dance).
